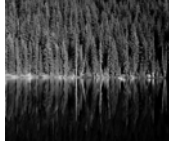


DES Water Supply Land Protection Grants

The Water Supply Land Protection Grant Program gives municipalities and land trusts the opportunity to obtain grants for the purchase of land or conservation easements to assist in the protection of community drinking water supplies.



Eligibility Requirements for Projects



HOW ARE PROJECTS RANKED?

The Water Supply Land Protection Grant Program rules state the exact number of points that are assigned for each value (Env-Dw 1002.13).

What affects the score of an application.

- Number of acres
- Riparian frontage
- Distance to drinking water supply source
- Type of water system
- Population size served by water supply



A HIGHLY RANKED PROJECT

- Over 250 acres of land.
- Protects an active municipal water system with extensive water protection measures. (such as educational program, water conservation, regulations, long term plan for meeting demand).
- Located between the sanitary radius and 600 feet out or within 400 feet of source water intake.
- Water system serves over 5000 customers.
